All entries must use the official ASCA entry form with the agreement. Incorrect or missing information (including signature) will invalidate entries. Please use one entry form per dog. Obedience and Rally have separate entry forms.

<u>OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED</u>: Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice B/A & Beginner Novice B/A. Group Sits and Downs to follow individual classes.

RALLY CLASSES OFFERED: Masters C/B/A, Excellent C/B/A, Advanced C/B/A, Novice C/B/A

<u>Schedule (both days)</u>: Trial #1: starts at 8:00 a.m. Trial #2 will begin 30 minutes after the end of Trial #1 but no earlier than 11:00 a.m.

### Awards:

Obedience: Ribbons for  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  -  $\mathbf{4}^{\text{th}}$ ; Awards for High in Trial, High Combined, High Scoring Junior and High Scoring Aussie or High Scoring Other Breed.

Rally: Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup>, X ribbons for scores 195 or over; Awards for HIT, High Combined, High Scoring Junior and High Scoring Aussie or High Scoring Other Breed.

### **Additional Information:**

- 1. Entry must be on CURRENT entry forms which can be found on the ASCA website (www.asca.org) under 'Forms & Rulebooks'.
- 2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Obedience and/or Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
- 4. No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries. Make checks payable to TCASWA and mail to Ann McCabe. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.
- 5. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
- 6. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS and keep your dog on a leash when not competing.
- 7. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- 8. Rally and Obedience are open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, with an ASCA Registration or ASCA QTracking number. We will have forms available at the trial (we will forward them to the ASCA office) but encourage you to apply for a QTracking number beforehand. The application can be found on the ASCA website.
- 9. TCASWA, their Boards of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the property owner assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
- 10. Show Grounds: The Show Grounds are the boundaries of the grounds on which ASCA events are being held. They include, but not limited to, all areas outside the ring/trial arena (including the buffer zone) set aside for grooming, holding of dogs, and parking of vehicles of the exhibitor.
